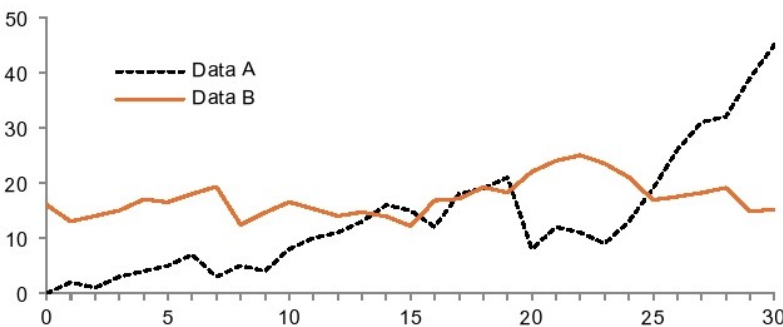


Figure 1: A figure caption is always placed below the illustration. Short captions are centered, while long ones are justified. The macro button chooses the correct format automatically.

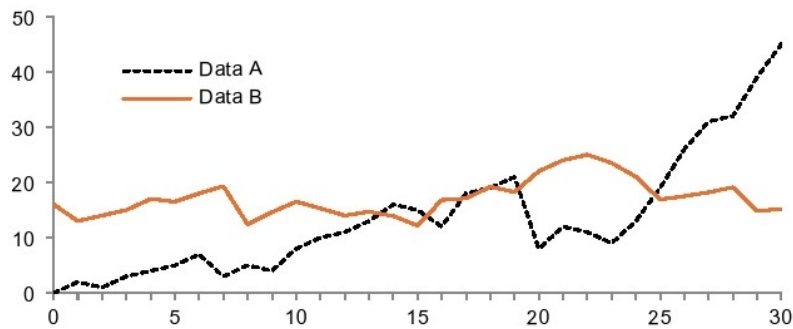


Figure 2: Short captions are centered.
